

Information & Documents Needed for Bankruptcy

Please check off the items as you gather them.

- Tax returns for this year and last year
- Pay stubs for months the last 7 months
- Statements of income from all sources, including but not limited to: wages, pension, subpay, interest, dividends, unemployment, social security, etc. for the last 3 months
- Bank Statements from the last 3 months
- 401K or IRA account statements
- Credit report if you have one. You can get a free one from www.annualcreditreport.com or phone: 877-322-8228. It is preferable to do this by Internet. Contact our office for assistance.
- Dates and case numbers of prior bankruptcies
- All bills and credit statements from the last 90 days
- Proof of child support obligation and support payment status including a statement of delinquency from the support collection agency, if any
- All divorce judgments or decrees
- Copies of all pending lawsuit papers (either where you are suing someone, or someone is suing you)
- Proof of insurance on all automobiles, mobile homes, and real estate
- Copies of all life insurance statements showing cash values
- Educational savings account information
- Tax assessments or tax bills and real estate or personal property appraisals, if any
- Documents referencing transfers of real estate or other property within the last 6 years
- Recorded deeds and mortgages to all real estate
- Copies of all leases for rental property or vehicles
- Titles to any vehicles where you are listed as an owner or co-owner, including automobiles, boats, motor homes, etc.
- Proof of any tithing or charitable giving for the past year
- Contracts for purchase of vehicles or other installment contracts for purchase of goods
